THE SANSOM FOUNDATION MUSIC AWARD RULES AND REGULATIONS 2025-26

The Sansom Foundation has been in operation since 1958. The Foundation focuses on music and the arts. High school students from Collier County, Bonita Springs and Estero will be eligible to compete for the Sansom Award worth \$3000.00 (yearly). The Award will permit the winners to receive private music lessons for one year with a teacher selected by the Music Foundation of Greater Naples. The award may be renewed one year at a time based on the Sansom Committee's assessment of the student's progress and the recommendation of his or her private teacher.

The award is intended for high school students whose families cannot afford private music lessons. However, private lessons in the past will not eliminate the candidate as long as they can attest that they are on the "Free and Reduced Lunch Program" and their family income is less than \$75,000 per year. A copy of the parent's recent tax return will be required. Students must complete the application, and have it signed by a parent and music instructor. If completing online (which is preferable), no signatures are required. Student applicants will also be required to submit a music teacher's recommendation, the student's most recent quarter grade reports and complete a "Questionnaire Prompt" at the end of this application (p.4). Finally, students will be required to participate in an audition that is scheduled for October 11, 2025. The audition solo should not exceed 4 minutes. No accompaniment is required. You can play/sing a short solo of your choice or a piece of music that you are presently working on in your school music ensemble.

Our expectations are that up to five awards or more per year will be allotted. If a student is allotted the award, they are also responsible for participating in two recitals per year. The recitals are scheduled for February 8 and June 7, 2026.

- The application and music teacher recommendation letter are due to the Sansom Chairman by October 4, 2025.
- <u>Audition Day</u> is <u>Saturday</u>, <u>October 11</u>, <u>2025</u> at Gulf Coast HS. Times TBA. Bring grades,
 Questionnaire Prompt, and Parents Tax Returns to the audition.
- Winners of the Sansom Award will be notified by email no later than October 14, 2025.

- 4. Be prepared to perform a short selection, no more than four minutes in length. No accompanist required.
- 5. Applicants must provide <u>one</u> original score and <u>two</u> evaluation copies of their music for the judges on competition day. The evaluation copies will be destroyed by the Music Foundation. No copies will be made at the audition site.
- 6. Applicants must dress appropriately for the audition. Girls should wear knee length or longer dresses/skirts or dress pants and blouse. Boys should wear a dress shirt, tie (optional) dress pants and shoes. No jeans, athletic wear, or sandals. School concert music uniform is also acceptable.
- 7. The completed application form and the music teacher's recommendation letter are due **October 4**, **2025**. Applicants will be disqualified if the application is incomplete or postmarked after the stated deadline.
- 8. There will be no registration fee for this award competition.
- 9. The Sansom Auditions will be **held Saturday, October 11, 2025, at Gulf Coast High School, Naples, FL 34119. Times TBA.**

All selected applicants will be notified by email of their specific audition time, no later than **Monday**, **October 6, 2025**. Please call 239-450-4035 if you do not receive the notification. The winners will be notified by email no later than **October 14, 2025**.

The decision of the judges is final. Private lessons for the winners will start in September or October/November 2025.
