The Mission of the Naples Music Club is to support music education and performance, to provide scholarships, and to engage in collaborative outreach efforts within Naples and its neighboring communities.

## Program Awards

**The Haegg Award** – The Haegg award was created in 2009 in memory of Margaret “Peg” Haegg by her husband Henry Haegg and her children. It provides talented, young students with the opportunity to have lessons. The award has a strong needs-based component. Peg moved to Naples in 1977 and became active playing the piano with “Forty Fingers,” a group that gave recitals to raise money for the club's Scholarship Fund.

**Naples Opera Society Award** – This award is funded by the Naples Opera Society to provide education and vocal training to young singers with an expectation of developing interest in opera, the art of performance, professional potential, and general music appreciation.

**Bert G. Phillips Award** – This annual award is funded by the Classic Chamber Concerts. It honors Bert Phillips, an outstanding cellist who contributed as a teacher and a performer in Naples and throughout the world. He was co-founder of the Classic Chamber Concert series as well as the Luzerne Music Center. The award is made to the most accomplished string instrumentalist in any given year.

**Clifford L. Saby Award** – Clifford Saby established the Clifford L. Saby Scholarship Fund in 1996 to provide scholarships for Collier County youth. His gifts enabled the Club to augment its scholarship awards and support the purchase of musical instruments in the public schools.

**Turiel Award** – This award was established in 1995 by Mr. & Mrs. Samuel Turiel, in memory of their son, Daniel, clarinetist, composer and conductor. It is presented to a 12th grader based upon competition score, music achievement, scholastic grade point average, an essay, a personal interview, and a recital performance.

## Outreach Programs

*Naples Music Club Sponsored:*

### **Middle School Band and Orchestra Master Classes**

Second year instrumentalists are provided five, ninety-minute lessons. These small group lessons (3-6 students) are taught by professional musicians. Forty-five students benefitted this year. The classes are offered to young people who have never studied privately. The Naples Music Club received a grant from the United Arts Council for this program.

### **Class Piano Lessons**

After school small group piano lessons are provided to students at Golden Terrace Elementary School and Bonita Springs Middle School. Thirty-six students are currently enrolled in this new program. The program is supported by the Laura Mahnil Fernando Memorial Fund.

*The Naples Music Club supports the following outreach programs that are funded collaboratively with other community organizations:*

### **Pre-K Violin Literacy Program**

Guadalupe Early Childhood Center

Seventy-two four-year-old children receive literacy-based violin lessons twice a week. The children are taught by FGCU Bower School of Music majors. The children develop better aural skills, pre-reading skills, fine motor skills and self-discipline.

### **Mariachi Program**

Pinecrest Elementary School

Thirty 3rd through 5th graders are learning violin and guitar as part of the Miracle Plus after school program. The children are taught by FGCU Bower School of Music majors.

# Naples Music Club History

The Naples Music Club was founded in 1965 by Tom and Grace Truesdale. Monthly musical programs were presented as a public service beginning in 1966, the year the Club originated a 90-minute radio program of classical music broadcast over radio station WNFM.

During the ensuing years, the Club has continued to present a series of musical programs, was an early participant in the Festival of the Arts, led a successful effort to enlarge the string curriculum in the public schools, sponsored “Sing Along Messiah” for many years, has worked to improve the performance skills of Immokalee music students, and has awarded scholarships to Collier County Students.

The Naples Music Club's Scholarship Program began in 1970 with one small grant awarded to a Collier County student, Anita Boqvist, for summer study. Since then, contributions from a generous community have made it possible to support more than 600 of the area's middle and high school students with over \$400,000 in scholarship aid. The Club's focus in 1970 of awarding scholarships to encourage and reward outstanding music students remains the most important part of its mission today, forty years later.

Several small performance groups for adult musicians have evolved within the Club since 1979. Both piano and instrumental groups meet on a regular basis to perform informally for each other or in concert. In 2008, an organized program of scheduled Student Recitals was initiated to enable students of member teachers to gain self-confidence, to practice good performance habits, and to enhance their listening skills.

Over the years, recognition has come from Immokalee High School, the School Board of Collier County for supporting its Choral Program, and the Collier County Education Foundation, which named the Naples Music Club an “Outstanding Partner in Education” in 1999, and in 2011 presented the club with its “Get on the Bus” award for supporting outstanding collaborative efforts involving a Pre-K Violin Literacy Program and an after-school Elementary School Mariachi program in Immokalee. In 2011 the club received the prestigious United Arts Council “Stars in the Arts” award.
